Amitai Adler is a Conservative rabbi (Ziegler School of Rabbinic Studies, 2010), with expertise in Jewish magic and mysticism, liturgy, and halachah (Jewish Law). Primarily a teacher of Jewish Studies, Rabbi Adler has also done work in the pulpit, and has done some writing; prior to the rabbinate, he has been an actor, a director, a tutor, and worked in various nonprofit organizations. The son of Rabbi Moshe Adler of Cleveland and Rabbi Dr. Rachel Adler (HUC Los Angeles), he is married to Rabbi Julie Adler, and is the father of two small children. Rabbis Amitai and Julie make their home in Evanston.



Hazzan Toby Lou Hayman is the Spiritual Leader of Central Synagogue, where she conducts Shabbat and holiday services and provides pastoral services to congregants in times of joy and sorrow. She is a dedicated teacher of Torah, Nusach, and biblical, prayer and conversational Hebrew. She is a graduate of the Jewish Theological Seminary. Hazzan Hayman has the distinction of being the first woman Hazzan to serve a Chicago area Conservative congregation. She has earned a Certificate in Spiritual Direction from the Yedidya Center for Jewish Spiritual Direction, and she offers group and individual spiritual direction, guidance, and companionship as a Spiritual Director.
